ORDER NO. 11 OF 1991

Revision of Penalties (Repeal) Order 1991

ORDER

To repeal the Revision of Penalties Proclamation 1952.

Enacted by the Military Council

Short title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Revision of Penalties (Repeal) Order 1991 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Gazette.

Repeal of Proclamation 17 of 1952 and savings

2. (1) The Revision of Penalties Proclamation 1952 is repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1),

(a) any legal proceedings pending prior to the commencement of this Order may be instituted, continued or enforced;

(b) any penalty or punishment pending prior to the commencement of this Order may be imposed,

as if this Order has not been passed.

ORDER No. 12 OF 1991

Lesotho Citizenship (Amendment) Order 1991

ORDER

To amend the Lesotho Citizenship Order 1971.

Enacted by the Military Council.

Short title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lesotho Citizenship (Amendment) Order 1991 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Gazette.

Amendment of section 9 of 0.16 of 1971

2. Section 9(1) (d) of the principal law is amended by deleting the word "five" and by substituting the word "ten".

Insertion of new section 9A of 0.16 of 1971

3. (1) The principal law is amended by inserting after section 9 the following new section,

"Application for registration of certain persons as citizen of Lesotho

9A. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Order or in any other law, application may be made to the Minister in Form AA of the Second Schedule for registration as a citizen of Lesotho by a person,

- (a) who has attained the age of twenty-one years; and
- (b) who is not suffering from mental incapacity; and
- (c) who is of good character; and
- (d) whose work, trade, commerce or industry will benefit and will not adversely affect,
 - (i) the social and economic conditions of Lesotho;
 - (ii) the social and economic interests of the residents in the area where the applicant is to reside or work;
 - (iii) the general interests of the population of Lesotho as a whole; and
 - (iv) the interests of defence, public safety, public health, public morality or fundamental human rights and freedoms.

(2) If a person by whom an application has been made in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) satisfies the Minister that he is qualified under that subsection so to apply, the Minister may, if in his opinion that person would, if registered, be a suitable citizen of Lesotho, order that that person be registered as a citizen of Lesotho, or otherwise the Minister may, order that person be not registered as a citizen of Lesotho."

Amendment of Part 1 of Second Schedule to 0.16 of 1971

4. Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal law is amended,
- (a) in paragraph 1 (ii) by deleting the word "five" and substituting the word "ten";
 - (b) by inserting "Form AA" immediately above "Form B".
